

In Four Card Poker® you receive five cards to make your best four-card poker hand, and the dealer receives six cards to make their best four-card poker hand. Four Card Poker also offers the optional Aces Up® and progressive wagers.

#### **GETTING STARTED**

Make an Ante bet to play against the dealer. You may also make the Aces Up and progressive wagers. Once all wagers have been placed, the dealer will give each participating player their five cards to make the best four-card poker hand.

The dealer receives six cards and turns the top card face-up.

### **DECISION TIME**

After looking at your hand, you have a choice: fold or make a Play bet 1x to 3x your Ante.

Note: If you fold, you forfeit your Ante wager. Your Aces Up wager remains in action and is resolved at the end of the round.

#### WINNING AND LOSING

The dealer then reveals their cards and announces the four-card poker hand. If your four-card poker hand beats or ties the dealer's four-card poker hand, your Ante and Play bets win even money. If your four-card poker hand loses to the dealer's four-card poker hand, your Ante and Play bets lose.

## **AUTOMATIC BONUS**

The top hands receive an Automatic Bonus paid on the Ante. You're eligible to receive an Automatic Bonus payout even if your four-card poker hand ties or loses to the dealer. See layout for odds.

#### **ACES UP**

The Aces Up pays if your four-card poker hand contains a pair of aces or better. See layout for odds.

#### PROGRESSIVE PAYOUTS

The progressive bet qualifies you for payouts from the progressive jackpot. See paytable for odds.

### **ENVY BONUS**

Top hands trigger Envy Bonus payouts. See paytable for payouts. You can receive multiple Envy Bonus payouts in a round, but you CANNOT receive Envy Bonus payouts for your hand or the dealer's hand.
